

REDUCED WATER & GARBAGE RATE POLICY
(Based on every other month billing cycle)

Effective November 15, 2001, all customers served by Giles County Public Water and Giles County Public Service Authority Garbage that meet the following criteria shall be entitled to a reduced water and garbage rate:

1. Total household income is *less than \$25,000* per year.
2. All residents of the household must be either, at least 65 years of age, or at least one person in the household must be totally disabled.

WATER: \$36.30 for minimum usage of 4,000 gallons. The rate for additional usage greater than the minimum of 4,000 gallons per billing cycle shall be \$4.13 per 1,000 gallons over minimum.

SEWER: \$37.54 for minimum usage of 3,000 gallons. The rate for additional usage greater than the minimum of 3,000 gallons per billing cycle shall be \$4.28 per 1,000 gallons over minimum.

The below rate schedule is based on a bi-monthly billing cycle.

GARBAGE: The rate for reduced garbage is as follows:

\$20,001 - \$25,000	\$33.40
\$15,001 - \$20,000	\$27.80
\$12,001 - \$15,000	\$22.22
Up to \$12,000	\$16.60

For backdoor service reduced rate, add \$1 per month to above rate.

In order to receive this reduced rate, please complete and return the enclosed application and include a copy of your Certificate of Disability, most recent W-2 tax forms and/or 1099 Social Security Benefits Statement from the previous year. Proof of this income must be submitted on a yearly basis to remain eligible for this program.
